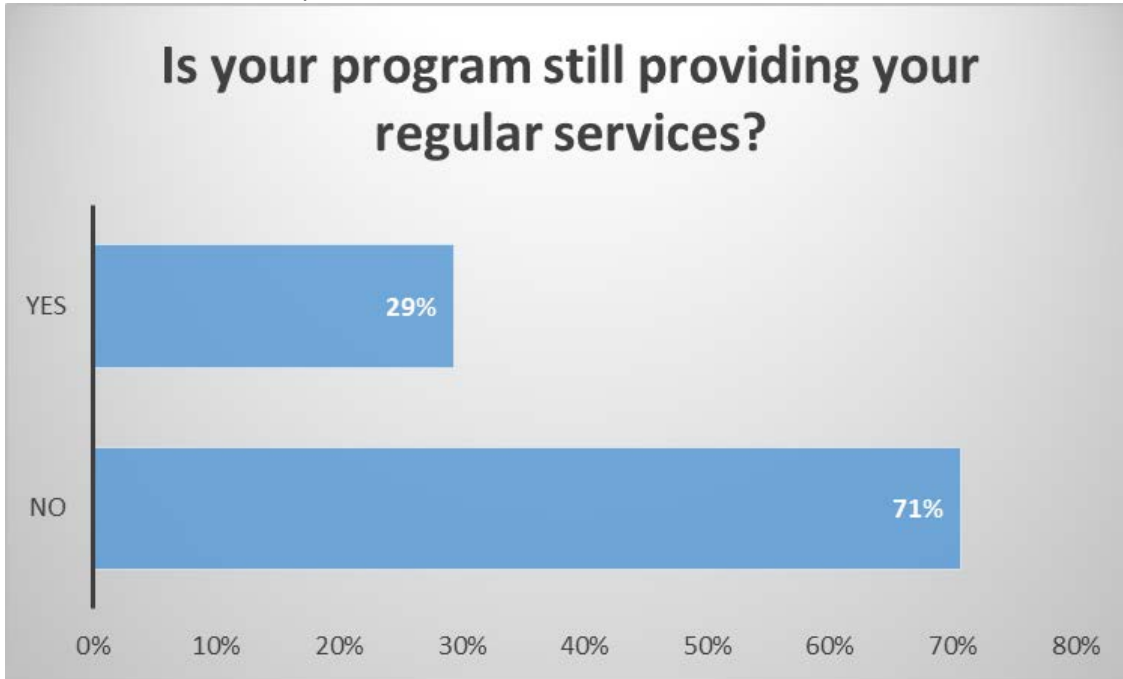

Question #1 N=75 unique answers



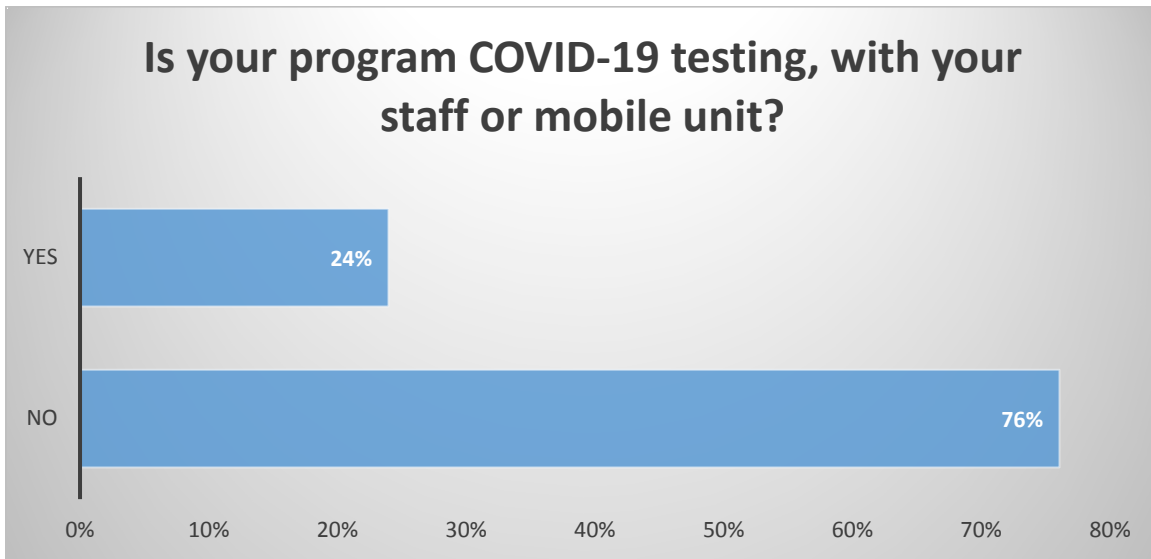
**In the 3/31/20 zoom meeting poll, out of 121 unique answers, 19% reported Yes and 81% reported No. On 4/27/20, out of 89 unique answers, 26% reported Yes and 74% reported No. Answers were anonymous, and this does not necessarily reflect the same cohort of programs.*

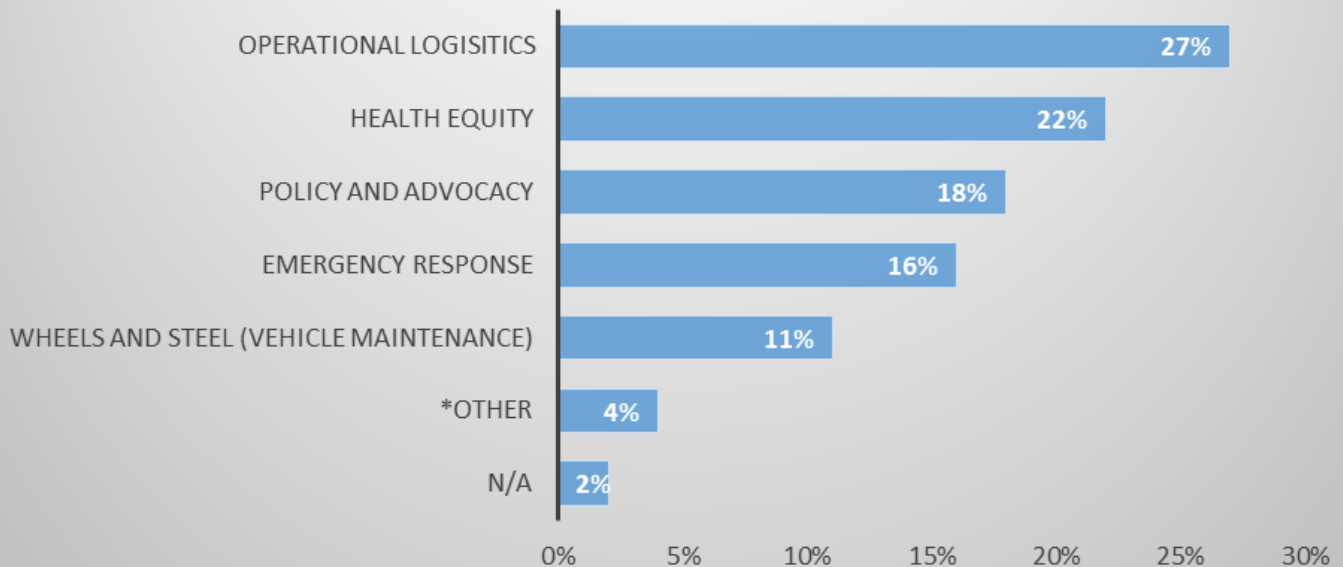
Question #3 N=85 unique answers, 204 responses (answer all that apply)
